Eligibility Criteria:

The Eligibility Criteria for the **Undergraduate** Course under Allied Health Courses is follows:

- 1. Minimum Age shall be 17 years on or before 31st Dec. of the Academic Year.
- 2. Minimum Educational qualification shall be passing of H.Sc Examination or Senior School Certificate Examination (10 +2) or Pre Degree Examination (10+2) or an equivalent with 12 years schooling form the recognized Board or University with science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Botany & Zoology) and English with

Minimum of 40%(PCBE). For SC/ST candidates – the minimum percentage of marks is 35%.

3. Candidate shall be Medically Fit.

Selection of candidates

The selection of candidates will be based on merit in the selection test. After the analysis of the application forms, the eligible students will be called for the written selection test of 100 marks will be of three hours duration and shall contain objective type question. The test will be based on higher secondary school certificate curriculum of physics, chemistry, biology, general knowledge and english. A follow-up interview on personal assessment (oral test of 50 marks) will also be held for short listed successful candidates of the written test.

The selected candidates, after the interview, will be subjected to medical examination and only medically fit candidates will be eligible for admission. Admission secured on the basis of false information will be cancelled and their fees forfeited.
