 and methods used in nursing for providing holistic nursing care to the sick in the hospital

- Develop the student's sensitivity and skill in human relationships and communication in daily work.
- Demonstrate critical thinking skills in making decisions in all situations in order to provide quality health care.
- Demonstrate leadership and administrative skills in working with the health care team, community and others in the provision of health care.
- Develop teaching as well as management skills and conduct need based research in various settings and utilize the research findings to improve the quality of health care.
- Recognize the need for continued learning for personal and professional development and contribute towards the advancement of self and to the profession.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Minimum Age shall be 17 years on or before 31st Dec. of the academics Year.
- 2. Minimum Educational qualification shall be passing of H.Sc Examination or Senior School Certificate Examination (10 + 2) or Pre -Degree Examination (10 + 2) or an equivalent with 12 years schooling form the recognized Board or University with science(Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Botany & Zoology) and English with Minimum of 45%(PCBE). For SC/ST candidates the minimum percentage of marks is 40%.
- 3. Candidate shall be Medically Fit

Selection of candidates

The selection of candidates will be based on merit in the selection test. After the analysis of the application forms, the eligible students will be called for the written selection test of 100 marks will be of three hours duration and shall contain objective type questions. The test will be based on Higher Secondary School Certificate Curriculum of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, General Knowledge and English. A follow-up interview on personal assessment (oral test of 50 marks) will also be held for short listed successful candidates of the written test. The selected candidates, after the interview, will be subjected to medical examination and only medically fit candidates will be eligible for admission.

Admission secured on the basis of false information will be cancelled and their fees forfeited.

Curriculum

The curriculum of the programme is based on the syllabus of the INC, TNNMC & Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University.

Course Details

Duration : 4 Years with Non – Semester examination including internship.

Course of study: It is prescribed by the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University.

Registration : The candidates admitted in the program shall be registered with

Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University by remitting prescribed fees and submitting the duly filled in application form for registration through The Principal, Vee Care College of Nursing. All the candidates admitted are subject to the regulations of Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University

and the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

Course

Commencement: In the month of July/August every Year

Payment of Fees: All the candidates shall pay the fees prescribed by the Government of

Tamilnadu from time to time. Fees once paid will not be refunded.

Candidates failing to pay the prescribed fees on time will have to pay with penalty till the date notified for the purpose. Non- Payment of college fees will attract appropriate action.

Attendance

A candidate is required to put in a minimum of 90% of attendance in both Theory and practical separately in each subject before admission to the examinations or all the years of study in B. Sc Nursing Degree .A candidate lacking in the prescribed attendance and progress in any one subject in theory and practical in the first appearance shall not be permitted for admission to the entire examinations.

Infrastructure Facilities

Hostel Facilities – Each student is provided in residing room with a bed, a locker, a table and chair. Students admitted in the hostel will be immunized against Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B and Typhoid on payment. Students are to strictly follow hostel rules. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the hostel.
